**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL  
AND FOR ISSUANCE OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY**

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**TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:**

Pamela Jo Linex Keenan, Applicant, for the purpose of probating the written will of Frances Jeanette Linex, Deceased (“Decedent”) and for Issuance of Letters Testamentary, furnishes the following information to the Court:

**I.**

Applicant has standing because she is the alternate Independent Executor named in Frances Jeanette Linex’s will. Applicant is a resident of the State of Texas whose address is 311 Highland Park Lane, Wylie, Texas 75098. The last three numbers of Applicant’s driver’s license number are 062, and the last three numbers of Applicant’s Social Security number are 953.

**II.**

Frances Jeanette Linex died on January 29, 2020, in Richardson, Dallas County, Texas, at the age of 81 years. Frances Jeanette Linex is one and the same person as Frances Linex. The last three numbers of Decedent’s driver’s license number are 256, and the last three

numbers of Decedent's Social Security number are 391.

**III.**

This Court has jurisdiction and venue because the deceased was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence in Dallas County at the time of death.

**IV.**

Frances Jeanette Linex owned property described generally as: cash, a homestead, and household furnishings and personal effects, having a probable value of more than \$10,000.

**V.**

Frances Jeanette Linex left a valid, unrevoked, written will bearing her signature and dated July 11, 2008, which is filed with this application.

**VI.**

Frances Jeanette Linex's will named Joe Linex to serve as Independent Executor of the estate, but Joe Linex predeceased her on September 11, 2012. The will named Pamela Jo Linex Keenan, formerly known as Pamela Jo Linex Moore, to serve without bond or other security as first alternate Independent Executor of the estate. Applicant requests that she be named Independent Executor of the estate.

**VII.**

The subscribing witnesses to the will are Elizabeth Gladman and June Oakley.

**VIII.**

No child was born to or adopted by the Decedent after the making of the will.

**IX.**

No marriage of the Decedent was ever dissolved after the will was made, whether by divorce, annulment, or a declaration that the marriage was void.

**X.**

Applicant is not disqualified by law from accepting letters testamentary. The will provides that no action be had or taken by the Probate Court other than probating the will and filing an inventory and appraisal of the estate and a list of claims.

**XI.**

The will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.

**XII.**

Neither Texas, nor any governmental agency of Texas, nor any charitable organization is named in the will as a devisee.

**WHEREFORE**, Applicant requests that citation be issued to all persons interested in this estate as required by law, that the will be admitted to probate, that letters testamentary be issued to Applicant, and that such other and further orders be made as the Court may deem proper.
